Call to Order

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Mr. Flateau called the meeting to order and Mr. Huber read the roll call confirming a quorum for the meeting.

Mr. Flateau asked if anyone present wanted to address the Board. Mr. Solkin addressed the Board regarding a DJ at the pool during the summer months. He stated that the HOA sent out an email blast to the residents regarding the DJ at the pool and received an overwhelming response in favor of having the DJ at the pool on Sundays. Mr. Solkin stated that the HOA is requesting to have the DJ perform at the pool on Sundays from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. He stated that the HOA would like to put signage out on Saturdays informing the residents of the DJ.

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The Board entertained audience comments regarding the DJ performing at the pool. Discussion ensued. The Board authorized the DJ to perform every other Sunday and if all goes well it can be revisited for every Sunday. On a Motion by Mr. Levy, seconded by Mr. Thomas, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the HOA Social Committee's request for a DJ every other Sunday (odd dates) through

Mr. Flateau asked if there were any other residents that wanted to address the Board.

August (12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.) for Ballantrae Community Development District.

Charlene Clark addressed the Board regarding her health and awareness seminars. She requested a renewal of the use of the clubhouse for the next quarter. There were no audience comments.

On a Motion by Mr. White, seconded by Mr. Bobick, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved Charlene Clark's request for the continued health and wellness seminars for July 25th, August 28th, and September 25th (6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.) for Ballantrae Community Development District.

Mr. Flateau stated that he would like the two vendors present to address the Board at this time starting with American Ecosystems.

Tony Smith from American Ecosystems presented and reviewed a proposal to transplant approximately 1,000 Pickerel Weed plants from pond #20 to the pond in the front of the community that had the recent erosion repairs. Discussion ensued regarding the ponds. Mr. Flateau and Mr. Smith entertained audience members' comments and questions.

On a Motion by Mr. Levy, seconded by Mr. White, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved American Ecosystems proposal to transplant Pickerel Weed from pond#20 to the pond in front of the community (1,000 plants at a cost of \$400.00) for Ballantrae Community Development District.

Discussion ensued regarding the County being in the community inspecting the ponds and inflow/outflow structures for the last couple of months. It was mentioned that the County is also in the process of updating their flood zone maps.

(Mr. Smith left the meeting in progress)

Mr. Shortstall from Florida Play Structures gave the Board an update on the splash pad and shade structure. He stated that there was an issue with the roofline of the shade structure. Mr. Shortstall gave a little background on the issue. He explained that the shade structure to be installed is a better design and better suited for the District's needs. Mr. Flateau gave the audience members more background on the issue of the shade structure design.

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Mr. Shortstall entertained the Board members' and audience members' questions regarding the shade structure.

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On a Motion by Mr. Bobick, seconded by Mr. Levy, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved a revised shade structure to be installed for Ballantrae Community Development District.

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Mr. Shortstall stated that that the shade structure should be completed by next week. Mr. Flateau stated that a gate is needed on the back side of the splash pad for Mr. Fletcher to have access. Mr. Shortstall stated that the gate should be installed next week at no charge. Mr. Flateau stated that the vendor who installed the fence wanted \$1,300 to install a gate. The Board released payment that was being held from Mr. Shortstall.

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Mr. Flateau moved to the presentation of the preliminary budget since there were members of the audience waiting for this item to be presented and discussed.

Presentation of Fiscal Year 2014/2015 **Preliminary Budget**

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Mr. Flateau briefly reviewed the budget process for the audience members. Mr. Huber presented the preliminary budget for fiscal year 2014/2015. He distributed the reserve study that was received earlier today. Mr. Huber stated that the annual amount indicated on the reserve study has been included in the preliminary budget. Mr. Flateau stated that the amount included from the reserve study is the same amount that is in the asset reserve. He stated that the reserve study is quite lengthy and could be included on next month's agenda for further discussion. Mr. Flateau stated that the assessments have not been increased in seven years. He stated that the total Operation and Maintenance budget is \$899,116.

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The Board entertained comments and questions from the audience members regarding the park development fund and amenity projects. Discussion ensued regarding the HOA making a donation to the CDD towards new amenity facilities. The Board entertained audience comments regarding lights for the tennis courts. Mr. Flateau stated that there is a curfew resolution in place and the facilities close at dusk. Discussion ensued regarding lighting the tennis courts. It was decided not to include the lighting of the tennis courts in the budget at this time.

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Mr. Flateau opened the floor for Board discussion on the preliminary budget. Discussion ensued regarding various projects and line items of the budget. Numerous adjustments were made to the budget.
